## **Terms of Reference**

The Committee on Space Allocation (COSA) is a subcommittee under the Administrative and Planning Committee (AAPC). Its terms of reference are as follows:

- 1. To make recommendations to AAPC on:
  - (a) the formulation of policies on space allocation; and
  - (b) long-term planning of space allocation in light of the further expansion of University programmes and physical development projects through consultation and negotiation with the concerned units.
- 2. To administer space allocation and utilization matters, including:
  - (a) the monitoring of space utilization in various facilities on campus (with the exception of student hostels and staff residences) and where necessary, initiating the reorganization of space; and
  - (b) considering of requests from faculties, departments or units for additional space within the context of the existing space allocation and policy planning.
